

# COACHING & OFFICIATING FUNDING INFORMATION

# **Funding Aims:**

The aim of the bursary scheme is to assist with the increasing need for netball coaches and umpires at all levels and environments within Wiltshire. The bursary has been set up for members to have access to gaining and improving coaching skills and umpiring qualifications in line with England Netball Coaching and Officiating Qualifications.

### Who Can Apply?

Any England Netball and Wiltshire individual member who wishes to achieve an England Netball Level 1, 2 or 3 coaching qualification. Any individual who wishes to achieve an Into, C Award, B Award or A Award Officiating qualification.

Applicants must be resident in Wiltshire or Swindon and will be using their qualification within the county.

#### Resources:

The maximum grant that can be applied for is 50% of the actual course cost (not to include transport or accommodation). In return of the grant, we ask that you deliver 3 x 1-hour voluntary sessions in a setting, including curriculum, extra-curricular, club and/or community setting.

For umpires, we would request that you support and umpire in two WCNA run tournaments/events or at your local league following successful accreditation.

# **Coach Bursary Scheme - Terms & Conditions**

- Applicants must live or deliver coaching in Wiltshire.
- Applicants must be England Netball and Wiltshire individual members.
- Applicants must hold an enhanced DBS disclosure certificate.
- Applicants must be working in line with the Minimum Standards for Deployment in particular for Level 2 coaches, 1st Aid and Safeguarding & Child Protection.
- Applications will be prioritised by local need. For example; coaching/officiating workforce or demand based on local insight data.
- Applicants must apply for the bursary before the start of their course date.
- Applicants of coaching qualifications have an honouring commitment in delivering 3 x 1-hour sessions in different settings, including curriculum, extracurricular, club and/or community settings.
- Applicants of officiating qualifications have an honouring commitment of supporting 2 County tournaments/events or events at local leagues.

- The 50% payment for the course will be made on completion of the course **and** once evidence of a pass certificate has been provided.
- To enable recording of bursaries provided a database will be held with the WCNA. The database will also be used for monitoring and evaluation purposes. No information will be given to any third party without prior consent.
- Applications will be assessed by the Chair and Treasurer with input provided by the Netball Development Officer where needed.
